Meets or exceeds the minimum VPK lead teacher requirement during the school year program.

After that date, an individual cannot be included in the Staff Credential Ratio. "No Expiration Date" indicates credential is always active and may always be included in the Staff Credential Ratio.

Early Childhood University of Florida - M.Ed. Early Childhood Education B.A., B.S., or Advanced Degree in Field.

Meets or exceeds the minimum VPK lead teacher requirement during the school year program.

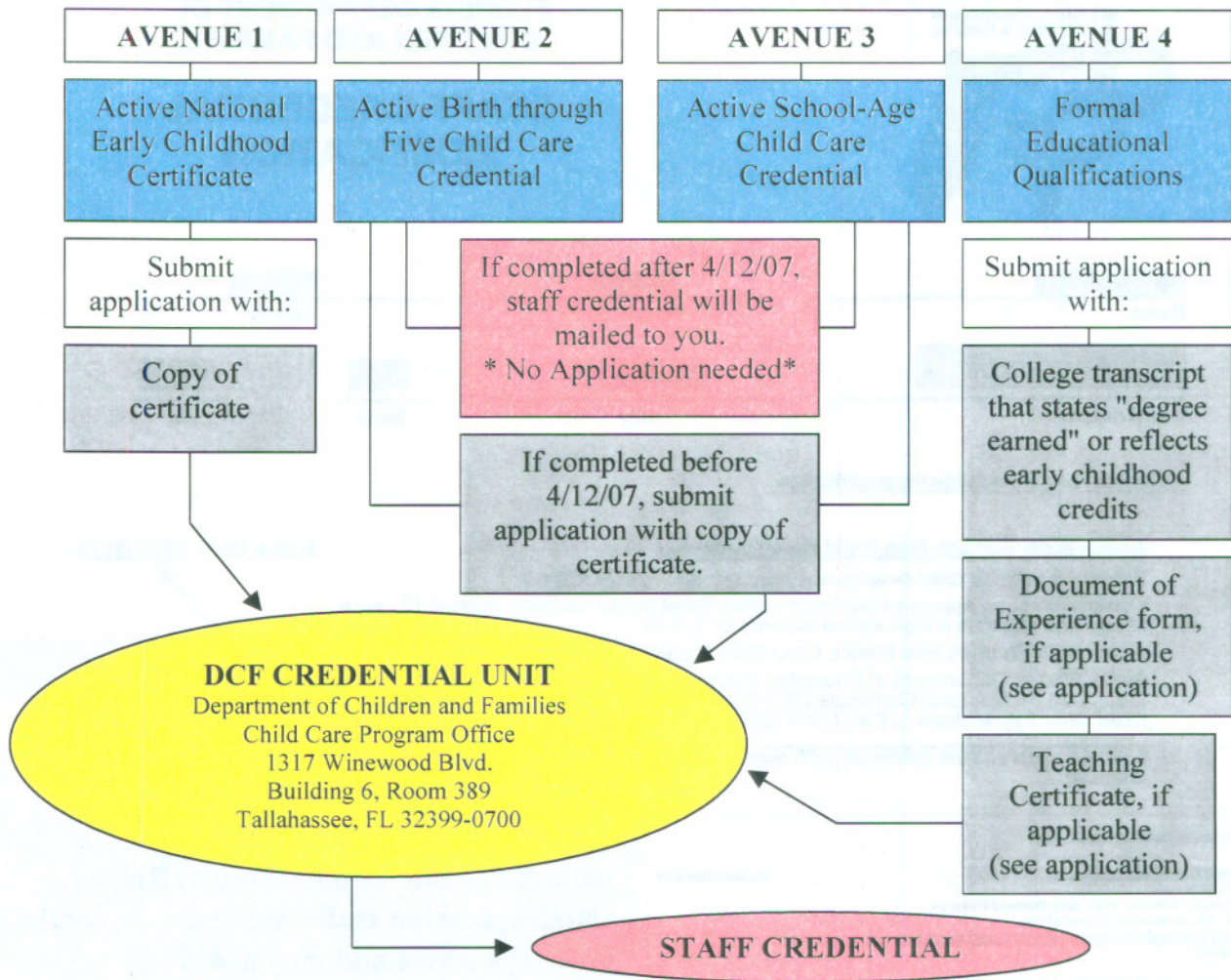
